Introduction

As you know the National Improvement Framework has been introduced to provide better information about how children and young people are progressing. This includes their progress through the early years and with their learning; the national awards and qualifications they obtain; their success on leaving school and their health and wellbeing.

The Knowing Me resource provides an ongoing self-evaluative tool that will support pupils to reflect and review themselves, to identify and evidence their own progress, achievements and development needs.

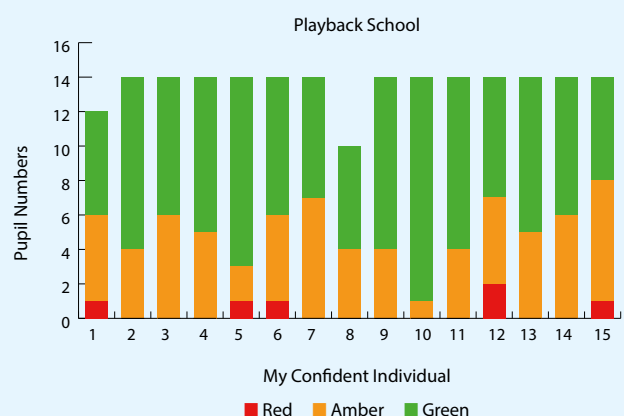
Sample statement from one area:
